Description

This product is a specifically formulated pre-spray concentrate for use on the new "5th Generation" anti-stain nylon carpeting. When used as directed, it will safely loosen hard to remove soils without affecting the carpet's stain resistant characteristics.

This product is concentrated for the most economical use. It contains no cationic additives which will neutralize the stain resistant properties of the carpet. Application must be followed by cleaning with an extraction shampoo specifically formulated for anti-stain carpeting.

This product can also be used successfully as a pre-spray on all other carpeting.

Recommended Uses

This product is recommended as a traffic lane pre-spray for use on anti-stain carpeting.

Directions

NOTE: Test a small area of the carpet to be cleaned with a towel dampened with shampoo to make sure the color is fast.

- 1. Pre-vacuum the carpet thoroughly to remove all loose soil.
- 2. Make up a ready to use solution by diluting approximately 16 ounces (2 cups) of this product per gallon of water.
- 3. Using a portable sprayer, apply the diluted product to the soiled carpet area and allow to dwell for 10 to 15 minutes.
- 4. Brush the applied area lightly with a hand pile brush.
- 5. Clean the area with an extraction shampoo specifically formulated for anti-stain carpeting. Follow directions carefully to avoid affecting the carpet's stain resistant characteristics.
